

6. Long Jumps (Both Men & Women)








Simple geometric forms, floral motifs, or extremely intricate designs can all be found in rangoli designs. Fish, mangoes, peacocks, and lotus flowers are a few of the often utilized Rangoli symbols. The most crucial component of a Rangoli is color!

Rangoli can be created on a sidewalk, the floor, or the front door of a house. You may easily find the supplies needed in a typical grocery shop, your backyard, or your pantry. Typical ingredients include beans and lentils to feed insects and birds, as well as plain or colored rice flour. Rangoli is not just meant to be attractive, but also meant to have significance for everyone, from distinguished visitors to the tiniest animals.
